Canastota AYSO Sportsmanship Policy

At the start of each season parents and players sign a code of conduct that clearly outlines the roles of parent, player and coach. For the success of our program and the adherence to AYSO national guidelines and philosophies, it is essential that all individuals involved follow this code of conduct. For other spectators present at games, we will have our sportsmanship expectations displayed on a sign at the fields.

WE HAVE ZERO TOLERANCE FOR POOR SPORTSMANSHIP! Anyone not following the guidelines set forth in the code of conduct and our sportsmanship policy will be asked to leave the field and, ultimately, may not be allowed to participate in our region.

If a player, parent or spectator is found to be in violation of the code of conduct or our sportsmanship guidelines, the following due process procedures will occur:

1. A verbal warning will be issued. This warning may be given by the coach, regional commissioner, assistant regional commissioner, referee, or CVPA (child and volunteer protective advocate).
2. A written complaint will be filed and a meeting will be scheduled with the sportsmanship committee. The coach, referee, RC, or CVPA may ask the individual to leave the field and not participate until this meeting occurs.
3. Copy of written complaint and meeting date is sent to individual (parents in the case of a player). Individual has seven days to share their position. This can be done in writing, via email, or in person at a meeting with the Sportsmanship Committee.
4. The Sportsmanship Committee (five non-affected individuals) will make a recommendation to the Regional Commissioner, who will make final determination and notify the involved individuals, and Area Director, of disciplinary action to be taken. Individual may be placed on probation, banned from events for a period of time or permanently barred from participating in our region.
5. Involved individuals may appeal decisions to the next highest executive member, usually the Area Director.
